The Community Foundation of Louisville is looking to support organizations with **grants of up to \$20,000** that enhance the safety, well-being, and educational outcomes of JCPS middle and high school students. Who can apply for this grant?

All nonprofit organizations who meet the following criteria are encouraged to apply:

- 501(c)3 status or fiscally sponsored project of a 501(c) organization
- Track record of Youth Services Center (YSC) collaboration supporting middle and high school students
- Support students living or attending schools in the following underserved zip codes: 40202, 40203, 40208, 40210, 40211, 40212, 40213, 40214, 40215, 40216, 40218, 40258

How many grants will be awarded?

Six

Is this a renewable grant opportunity?

No. This is a one-time grant.

What if my nonprofit works with a JCPS Family Resource Center in an elementary school?

This grant is for YSCs that work with middle and high schools only.

How can these grant dollars be used?

An opportunity to provide nonprofits who are partners for YSCs with \$20,000 in unrestricted operating support. These dollars can be used for:

- Staffing
- Transportation
- Professional development
- Supplies
- Any other expenses that strengthen and continue your work

Can two nonprofits partner together?

Yes! Identify one organization to be the lead and provide contact information for the lead organization. This individual will be contacted for any updates or questions regarding your application.

I have a program idea that I want to start at a school I have never worked with.**Can I apply for this grant?**

No. This grant is for nonprofits with an established relationship with a YSC.
